As a supplement to the mailing of the NYSDEC fact sheet you have received, we would like to provide additional information regarding the upcoming activity at the 50 Kent Avenue property of the former Williamsburg Works Manufactured Gas Plant (MGP) Site (the Site), located at Kent Avenue and N. 12th Street, Brooklyn. As National Grid is committed to keeping the community informed of our activities during this work, we will continue to post updates on our website (williamsburgmgpsite.com). The work is part of an Interim Remedial Measure (IRM) set to begin in late November and will address contamination related to the operation of both the former MGP and more recent commercial and industrial operations that have occupied the 50 Kent Avenue property. The non-aqueous phase liquid (NAPL) recovery is ongoing.

The goal of the IRM is to conduct a cleanup at the site that protects public health and the environment. This IRM is being prioritized to allow prompt cleanup of the City-owned 50 Kent Avenue property, which is part of NYC Parks' long-term park development plan.
